Program Budget Committee Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, December 1, 2020

Wildwood City Hall, 16860 Main Street, Wildwood, Missouri 63040

The Program Budget Committee Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, December 1, 2020, at Wildwood City Hall, 16860 Main Street, Wildwood, Missouri 63040, and on Zoom Platform.

I. Call to Order and Opening Remarks by Chair Garritano

Chair Garritano opened the meeting and welcomed all members.

II. Roll Call of Committee Members

A roll call of members was taken, with the following results:

Present: Council Members Edens, Garritano, and McCutchen.

Absent: None

Staff Present: Interim City Administrator Cross, Economic Development Director Jacquin, Director of Planning and Parks Vujnich, and Assistant Director of Planning and Parks Arnett

III. Approval of Minutes from the Committee's October 28, 2020 Meeting

A motion was made by Council Member Edens, seconded by Council Member McCutchen, to approve the October 28, 2020 meeting minutes. A voice vote was taken on the motion, with no opposition, and Chair Garritano declared the motion approved.

IV. Review of Proposed Modifications to Programming Offered by the Department of Planning and Parks and the Economic Development Committee (EDC)

Director of Planning Vujnich reviewed the spreadsheet, which was part of the provided memorandum, and outlined proposed modifications to the Department's programming of events. The modifications included the elimination of four (4) events: Hidden Valley Snow Sports Day; Arbor Day Be Brave 5K; Plein Air Art Reception; and monthly Scrapbooking events. The elimination of events equates to a twenty-seven thousand dollar (\$27,000.00) annual cost savings. Staff is also proposing fee increases to seven (7) events, including: the Frozen Feet Half Marathon, the Weekend Scrapbooking Event, the Cabin Fever Hike, the GreenRock Trail Challenge, the Tour de Wildwood, the Shivering Shadows 7K, and the Early Childhood Recreation Program. Increases are viewed as nominal, but would equate to approximately twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) in increased annual revenue.

Discussion was then held on the following items: the loss of the sag wagon and other support during the Tour de Wildwood; the potential to charge for the Centaur Time Trial; the attempt to get sponsors for the Tour de Wildwood Event; the desire to increase the GreenRock Trail Challenge entry fee to \$25.00 per person; the desire to charge \$10.00 for pre-registration cost of the Plein Air Event and more for event day registration; the potential for the committee to make a statement regarding a post-COVID approach to event planning and budgeting that is closer to a revenue neutral model; the potential for having scrapbooking each month, but not providing food; the desire to reduce the cost of the Back to School Party; the potential to charge a fee for booth spaces at the Art Festival and Celebrate Wildwood Events; the preference to combine the Celebrate Wildwood and Art Festival Events; the desire to understand the cost per person of each event; the cost of Zoom Bingo and Trivia is for the

software and the prizes; and the cost of Babysitting 101, with lunch served to the attendees, so there is a potential to charge the attendees for the class.

V. Introduction of City Assessed Fees

Interim City Administrator Cross noted the list of fees the City charges for a range of services is being provided for review. At the next meeting, Staff will offer recommendations for modifications.

Discussion was then held regarding the desire for at least a minimal fee increase, comparable to the percentage of inflation, since the fee had been set in 1995, which is \$0.71 per dollar, and the desire to review solicitor's fees.

VI. Other Items

By consensus, the Committee Members decided to reschedule the next meeting from December 10th, until after the first of the year. Staff will send an email to check availability.

VII. Closing Remarks and Adjournment

A motion was made by Council Member McCutchen, seconded by Council Member Edens, to adjourn. A voice vote was taken, hearing no objections, and Chair Garritano declared the meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
