Re: Proposed Aesthetic Enhancements to Route 100 at Route 109

As you may recall, at the October meeting of the Admin/Public Works Committee, several aesthetic concepts for Route 100 at Route 109 were presented as prepared by Ken Keitel of Terraspec for review and comment. The concepts would provide aesthetic enhancements beyond that which is currently planned for the Route 109 bridge over Route 100. At the meeting, the Committee favored the concept shown below as **Exhibits 1-3**, which would provide enhancements to Route 100, for both the eastbound and westbound directions of travel.

After the meeting, Mr. Keitel forwarded the concept to MoDOT for their initial review and comment. Unfortunately, the response we received from MoDOT was not favorable. MoDOT staff indicated they would not support the installation of new walls within the right of way, as they could be a safety hazard to vehicles that run off the road. They were supportive of a similar approach which would require the use of panels, if they are installed on break-away supports (as is required with roadways signs).

Therefore, Ken Keitel has developed a revised concept for your consideration, which is shown below as **Exhibit 4**. Please note that additional renderings are being developed of the revised concept and these will be provided to you on Tuesday evening. Ken Keitel and I will be available to address any questions, or comments regarding this concept at the January 8, 2019 meeting of the Admin / Public Works Committee.

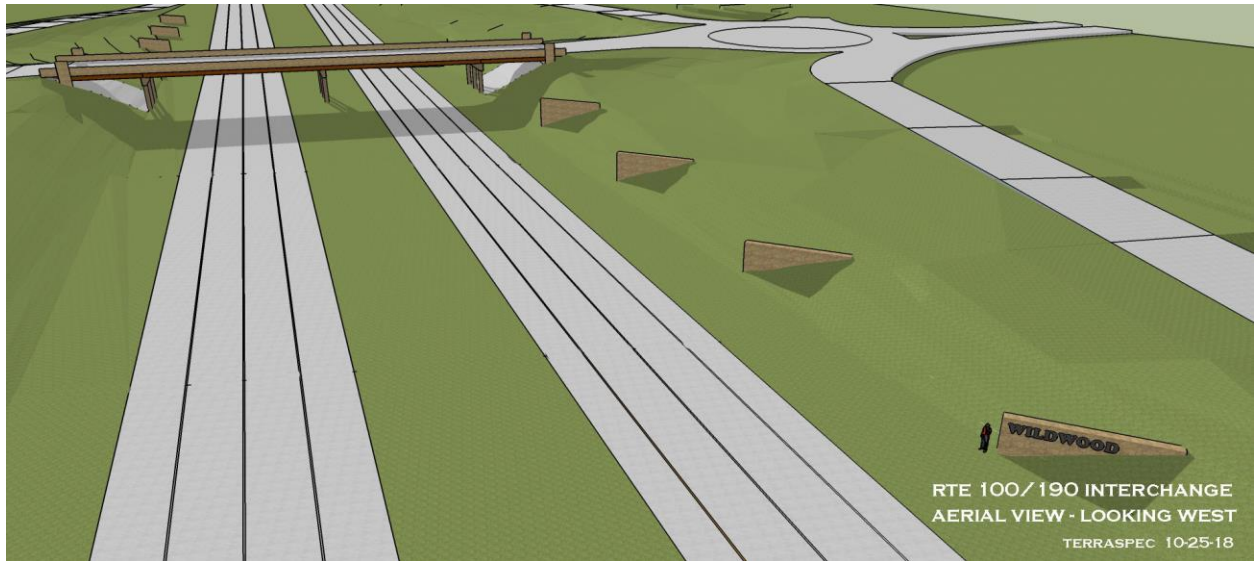
