Re: Review of Contractor Bid for 2019 CRF Restorative Seal Project

For 2019, \$650,000 is budgeted for resurfacing work. As part of this budget, the Department is planning to treat some rural roads with a restorative asphalt sealant. Therefore, on January 22, 2019, a sealed bid was opened for the FY-2019 CRF Restorative Seal Contract. As this is a specialty product, we only received one bid from Corrective Asphalt Materials (CAM), LLC, in the amount of \$92,086.65. (See **Exhibit A.**) Our estimated cost for the project was \$107,078.40.

Roadways included in the project are shown in the table below.

This project was previously used by the Department in 2012 and was found to be very cost-effective approach to maintaining low volume asphalt pavements. In fact, Bouquet, Hencken and Manchester Roads were completed during 2012 with the CRF restorative seal by CAM and the Department has been very pleased with the results.

### Recommendation

The Department of Public Works is recommending a contract with Corrective Asphalt Materials, LLC for the FY 2019 CRF Restorative Seal Project for \$ 92,086.65 (bid amount) plus a \$9,208.67 contingency for additional work as identified by the Department. The maximum authorization under the agreement is \$101,295.32.

### Reasons for Recommendation

- The bid from CAM for \$1.29/square yard is cost effective when compared to other asphalt surfacing options.
- The Department utilized CAM in 2012 when the CRF restorative sealant was utilized on several City streets. We were very pleased with the results.

With a motion from the Committee approving this recommendation, the Department will prepare a bill authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with Corrective Asphalt Materials, LLC for the project. The bill will be submitted to the City Council for consideration.
