

RESOLUTION #2019-11

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A PORTABLE METAL DETECTOR, AND ASSOCIATED HAND WANDS, THROUGH THE USE OF PROPOSITION P FUNDS FOR MUNICIPAL COURT SAFETY AND OTHER BUILDING SECURITY NEEDS ASSOCIATED WITH ITS USE FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES. (Wards – All)

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood, Missouri has always been aware of the need for building security and have addressed it through the series of steps and improvements at all three (3) buildings that have acted as its City Hall facilities; and

WHEREAS, with advances in technology, the availability of newer equipment that is portable in nature can now be added to facilities like the Wildwood City Hall; and

WHEREAS, with the passage of legislation by the Missouri House of Representatives and Senate of conceal and carry rights for firearms, the need for metal detectors has become more essential to create a complete and tailored security system for all users, City officials, and Wildwood employees within City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the St. Louis County Police Department – Wildwood Precinct has completed the research and pricing associated with a portable metal detector, and associated hand wands, for the purposes of Wildwood’s City Hall facility; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this equipment is **six thousand nine hundred twelve dollars and eighteen cents (\$6,912.18)** and offered by **Hackett Security, Inc.**, which is consistent with the identified specifications and needs for such and can be purchased through the use of Proposition P funds that are collected for the purposes of police services and public safety needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wildwood, Missouri believes the use of these Proposition P funds is appropriate in this case and will increase the safety of all visitors and others to the City Hall facility hereafter.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The City Council of the City of Wildwood, Missouri hereby authorizes the purchase of a portable metal detector, and associated hand wands, from **Hackett Security, Inc.** for their deployment and use at City Hall facility for municipal court purposes, as well as other meetings that are held at this location almost every night of the week.

Section Two. This Resolution is approved and authorized on a not-to-exceed basis of **seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.00)**, as set forth in the attached proposals, which are identified in Exhibit A.

Section Three. Said Resolution shall be effective and in full force from the date of its passage.

Dear Mr. Brown,

On January 10, 2019, the Public Safety Committee for the City of Wildwood was presented with the issue and discussed security and safety concerns related to the Municipal Court. The suggestion was made for a walk-through type metal detector to be put in place in order to provide screening by police security staff of those entering the court. Such screening would enhance safety for court staff and others present in the courtroom. In addition, the suggestion was made to provide for hand-held detectors to be available for unusual circumstances or equipment failures. The Public Safety Committee endorsed the need for this equipment and requested that the necessary purchases be pursued.

Members of my staff have evaluated equipment that is available. On February 7, 2019, a representative from Hackett Security visited with us at the City Hall to evaluate the site for an equipment recommendation. They have recommended the CEIA PMD2 HI-Performance Metal Detector. This model has a proven work history and is utilized by the Department of Homeland Security at most airports. It addition, it is used locally at various government facilities to include the County Government Center in Clayton. It is further recommended that three hand-held devices, CEIA model PD240, be purchased as the supplemental equipment. The total cost should be approximately \$7626.56 .
