RE: Livestreaming All Meetings

Mayor Bowlin and Council Members,

Effective March 5, 2019, the City now has the ability to livestream almost the full schedule of the City's public meetings held in both the Council Chambers and now the Community Room. In fact, on Tuesday, March 5, 2019, the Administration and Public Works Committee meeting was livestreamed from the City Hall Community Room for the first time.

Please note that public meetings being held concurrently in the Council Chambers and the Community Room cannot both be livestreamed at the same time. Team Members are exploring options to be able to accomplish this simulcast, but, it is of importance to note this situation, where public meetings are running concurrently in both rooms, does not happen very often. City officials need to be cognizant of the cost of being able to provide this functionality, with the infrequent need to be able to do so.

The primary purpose of this memorandum is to determine if the Mayor and Council wish to livestream more or less meetings than currently planned.
