RE: Bill for Compensation of Appointed Officials

Mayor Bowlin and Council Members,

At the February 11, 2019 City Council Work Session, Council voted to approve the recommendation of the Administration and Public Works Committee for compensation increases for several appointed officials, and directed the preparation of legislation consistent with the recommendation. One of the appointed officials that was part of that recommendation was the City's Provisional Municipal Judge.

At the March 5, 2019 Administration and Public Works Committee meeting, the Committee members reconsidered the compensation increase for the Provisional Municipal Judge and decided to withdraw its recommendation for that increase. The proposed Bill that is currently before the Council reflects the amended recommendation as noted above.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICES OF MUNICIPAL JUDGE, PROSECUTING ATTORNEY, CITY TREASURER AND CITY MARSHAL

WHEREAS, Section 4.7(e) of the City Charter provides that “The Council shall fix by ordinance the compensation of the Prosecuting Attorney;” and

WHEREAS, Section 4.7(g) of the City Charter provides that “The Municipal Judge shall serve a term of two (2) years. The Council shall fix by ordinance the compensation of the Municipal Judge;” and

WHEREAS, Section 4.7(i) of the City Charter provides that “The Council shall fix by ordinance the compensation of the City Treasurer;” and

WHEREAS, Section 4.7(j) of the City Charter provides that “The Council shall fix by ordinance the compensation of the City Marshal;”

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Effective July 1, 2019, the compensation for the office of Municipal Judge for the City of Wildwood, Missouri, shall be Twenty-two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000) per year, payable in equal monthly installments.

Section Two. The compensation for the office of Prosecuting Attorney for the City of Wildwood, Missouri, shall be Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) per year, payable in equal monthly installments.

Section Three. That Section 115.350 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Wildwood, Missouri, be and is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced, in lieu thereof, with a New Section 115.350, to read as follows:

Section 115.350 Compensation.

The compensation of the Treasurer shall be Five Thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year.

Section Four. That Section 115.390 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Wildwood, Missouri, be and is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced, in lieu thereof, with a new Section 115.390, to read as follows:

Section 115.390 Compensation.

The compensation of the Marshal shall be One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00) per year, unless declined.

Section Five. Savings. Nothing contained herein shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other Ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in any manner connected with the subject matter hereof, unless expressly set forth herein.

Section Six. Severability. If any term, condition, or provision of this Ordinance shall, to any extent, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder hereof shall be valid in all other respects and continue to be effective and each and every remaining provision hereof shall be valid and shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law, it being the intent of the City Council that it would have enacted this Ordinance without the invalid or unenforceable provisions. In the event of a subsequent change in applicable law so that the provision which had been invalid is no longer invalid, said provision shall thereupon return to full force and effect without further action by the City and shall thereafter be binding.

Section Seven. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

This Bill was passed and approved this ____ day of _____, 2019, by the Council of the City of Wildwood, Missouri, after having been read by title or in full two (2) times prior to passage.
