A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, OPPOSING THE PROPOSED "BETTER TOGETHER" PLAN.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The City of Wildwood incorporated in 1995 to preserve the quality of life in an area and environment in which the residents live and to promote the safety of all residents.

Section Two. The City of Wildwood incorporated to provide accountability to the residents. To place the responsibility for governance with the people of the area so that each would have a voice that would be heard by local, responsible representatives. Not being governed by some distant board or Council.

Section Three. The City of Wildwood also incorporated in 1995 to protect the many varied assets of the area.

Section Four. The City of Wildwood also incorporated to create a new model for municipal government. One which limits the sprawl of government while serving its constituents.

Section Five. That the City Council of the City of Wildwood adamantly opposes the Better Together plan that would eliminate the clear mandate that the residents of Wildwood voted for in 1995.
