Re: Construction Project Updates

Following is an update on all active City construction projects. The Departments of Public Works and Planning/Parks will be available for any questions at the April 8, 2019 City Council Meeting.

John L. LeCave Memorial Trailhead: Gershenson Construction will continue working on this new trailhead located along Centaur Road this spring, as weather allows. This project will provide parking, a rest area, restroom facilities, and user access to the Monarch-Chesterfield Levee Trail that is much safer relative to sight lines and is scheduled to be completed by early this summer.

Manchester Streetscape – Phase 3: The contract for this project has been awarded to Gershenson Construction. Various utility companies will continue completing relocation work in the next few months as weather allows, with construction anticipated to begin later this spring. This project will complete pedestrian and streetscape enhancements along Manchester Road between Taylor Road and Eatherton Road.

2019 Street Slab Replacements: The contractor is scheduled to begin 2019 concrete street slab replacement work in the next few weeks, weather permitting. They will be working in Wildhorse and Pine Creek Subdivisions in April as weather permits. They plan to begin working in Winding Woods, Dartmouth, Winding Trails, Babler Park Estates, Tall Oaks, Westglen Farms, Fairhaven Estates, Cherry Hills, Nantucket, Crown Pointe and Wynncrest Subdivisions later this spring and summer.

Clayton Road Sidewalk Extension: The contractor completed the sidewalk construction for this project and plans to complete the restoration work over the next few weeks as weather allows. This project completes the section of sidewalk along the north side of Clayton Road, from Anniversary Park to McBride Pointe Drive.

Forby Road Bridge Replacement: The contractor is scheduled to begin this project in the next few weeks as weather allows. This project will replace the existing substandard bridge on Forby Road, just west of Spoonville Road.
