

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING JESSICA STIRMLINGER TO THE OFFICE OF CITY CLERK FOR THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI; AND ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE CITY CLERK

WHEREAS, there exists a vacancy in the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 4.7(b) of the City Charter, “The Mayor with advice and consent of a majority of the members of the City Council shall appoint an officer as City Clerk, who shall serve an indefinite term of office at the pleasure of the Mayor and of the Council. [...] The Council shall fix by ordinance the compensation and conditions of employment of the City Clerk;” and

WHEREAS, Jessica Stirmlinger has been appointed by the Mayor to serve as City Clerk for the City of Wildwood, Missouri, effective as of August 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that Jessica Stirmlinger possesses the necessary qualifications and experience to serve as the City Clerk for the City of Wildwood;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. In accordance with Section 4.7(b) of the City Charter, Jessica Stirmlinger is hereby appointed to the Office of City Clerk for the City of Wildwood, Missouri, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and City Council for an indefinite term beginning at 12:01 a.m. on August 13, 2019. Upon the commencement of her term, Jessica Stirmlinger is hereby authorized to perform all duties required of a City Clerk by Missouri Law, the City Charter and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Wildwood.

Section Two. For serving as City Clerk, Jessica Stirmlinger shall be paid compensation at the rate of Sixty-five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$65,500.00) per year, or such compensation as may hereafter be amended from time to time by the City Council and reflected in the budget adopted by the City, such compensation to be paid in the same manner as all other employees of the City are paid. During her term, Jessica Stirmlinger shall be covered under the same employee benefit plans provided to all other full-time officers and employees of the City and to such other benefits as may be provided for by ordinance.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

This Bill was passed and approved this ____ day of August, 2019, by the Council of the City of Wildwood, Missouri, after having been read by title or in full two (2) times prior to passage.
