

RESOLUTION #2019-34

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI,
ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR SCHEDULING MEETINGS IN
THE MONTHS OF JUNE, JULY AND AUGUST OF EACH YEAR**

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood prides itself on operating an efficient and effective government with a limited but dedicated team of employees; and

WHEREAS, City team members are often called upon to facilitate and attend the meetings of the City Council and the various boards, committees, commissions and tasks forces of the City; and

WHEREAS, over the past several years, the number of meetings that City team members have been called upon to facilitate and attend have increased; and

WHEREAS, continuing to request City team members to facilitate and attend these increasing number of various meetings may impact their efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is to the benefit of the provision of government services and the overall morale of the dedicated City team members that provide those services that no meetings be scheduled for at least one calendar week during each of the months of June, July and August of each year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That it is hereby declared the policy of the City Council that there be identified for each calendar year one calendar week in each of the months of June, July and August during which no meetings of the City Council or any board, committee, commission or tasks force of the City shall be held.

Section Two. That the City Council shall take such action as may be necessary from time to time to effectuate the policy set forth in Section One of this Resolution.

Section Three. That the City Administrator is hereby directed and authorized to take such action as may be necessary to identify and present to the City Council and the various boards, committees, commissions and tasks forces of the City meeting schedules implementing the policy set forth in Section One of this Resolution.

Section Four. This resolution shall be effective upon passage and approval.
