Re: City Priorities for Future Improvements to MoDOT Roads

Last fall, the Board of Public Safety developed a list of prioritized improvements for state routes within the City of Wildwood. This effort was undertaken, in large part, due to the potential for MoDOT to receive a significant increase in revenue from the proposed motor fuel tax increase that was considered by voters one year ago. The Board's effort was intended to provide a means for the City to express our priorities to MoDOT for future improvements to MoDOT routes, primarily Route 109 and Route 100, but also Route BA (Babler Park Drive), Route T (St. Albans Road), and Route CC (Wild Horse Creek Road). A copy of the prioritized list follows this memorandum.

While the proposed fuel tax increase did not pass, the need for the City to clearly express our priorities to MoDOT has not diminished, as competition for funding is extremely competitive and largely limited to projects that address safety or preservation of their system. From the perspective of the Department, the development of the list is beneficial, not only to express our priorities to MoDOT, but also to identify those projects, on state roads, where the City may want to consider submitting applications for federal or state funding.

Therefore, the Department is requesting the guidance of the Board with respect to last year's effort to prepare the list of prioritized projects. Would the Board prefer to review and/or develop an updated list of projects for 2020? Last year, the prioritized list, which was developed and approved by the Board, was sent to the City Council for their review and approval.

I will be available to address any questions or concerns regarding this matter at the November 7th meeting of the Board of Public Safety.
