Listed below is a summary of the programs and activities the City has completed, or are underway, at this time relative to implementing the goals and recommendations that were set forth in the Parks Action Plan Update Committee's [Action Plan 2018](#). This summary reflects major items that have been the focus of the City, since the Committee's February 2020 meeting:

### **March Scrapbooking Event:**

- The March Scrapbooking Event took place on March 3, 2020, at Wildwood City Hall.
- The event had nineteen (19) participants in attendance.
- The event is held in the Community Room, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- The event remains popular, with a routine attendance of over fifteen participants when presented.

### **Sculpture on the Move**

- The City has been lucky to receive another sculpture to be displayed within the City of Wildwood through the 'Sculpture on the Move' Program (see attached photograph).
- The City now has two (2) pieces of sculpture, as a result of the program (*Frisbee Dog* is on display at the Community Garden)
- The *Sculpture on the Move Program* is a collaboration of several cities in the area.
- Various pieces of art are presented on a quarterly basis and each city selects pieces they would like to have for display.
- Each selected piece is awarded based upon a specific set of rules.

### **Wildwood Family Day at Hidden Valley**

- The City again worked with Hidden Valley Ski Resort to host a Wildwood Family Snow Sports Day on February 23, 2020.

- One hundred forty-nine (149) passes were distributed on February 13<sup>th</sup>, with one hundred fourteen (114) of them being redeemed on the day of the event.
- Fifty-seven (57) tubing hill and fifty-seven (57) ski lift tickets were redeemed.
