Re: Construction Project Updates

The following is an update on all active City construction projects. The Departments of Public Works and Planning/Parks will be available for any questions at the June 22, 2020 City Council Meeting.

Manchester Streetscape – Phase 3: Gershenson Construction continues to work on pavement widening, driveway approaches, parking areas, and curb along the north side of the project. Sidewalk work will continue on both sides of the road for the next several weeks. Almost all driveway approaches are complete. Gershenson plans to pave base asphalt at the back side of the entrances and parking lots by the end of the month, weather permitting. Once the parking lots are paved, construction conflicts with existing businesses should be reduced significantly. This project will complete pedestrian and streetscape enhancements along Manchester Road between Taylor Road and Eatherton Road.

Route 109 MoDOT Project: The 109 roundabout and new bridge is complete. There are a few punch list items that are being addressed by MoDOT but all construction on this project should cease very soon. The new bridge and roundabouts are fully open to traffic.

Eatherton Road Bridge Replacement: The contract for this project has been awarded to Pace Construction Company. This project consists of replacement of the Eatherton Road bridge between Route 109 and Wild Horse Creek Road. Construction started on June 1 with clearing commencing right away. The contractor is working on installing the eastern rock slopes to help prevent erosion of the creek banks in the future. Bridge demolition is taking place Monday June 15. Pile driving for the new bridge will commence this week. The project is scheduled to be complete by August, weather permitting. Eatherton Road, at the bridge location, will be closed for the duration of the project.

Westhampton Woods Turn Lane: E. Meier has been contracted to install a dedicated right turn lane into the Westhampton Woods Subdivision off of Hwy 109. The concrete pavement, sidewalk and asphalt pavement are complete. The contractor will complete the necessary striping soon.
