  - a. Initial review and discussion of Architectural Elevations and related materials for certain modifications to a historic building within the City's Town Center Area (Pond Historic District), specifically the addition of overhead doors on the front and back elevations. The subject property is on the City's Historic Registry and known as the Kern Service Station; north side of Manchester Road, west of Pond Road (17301 Manchester Road/St. Louis County Locator Number: 23W310241). – **Ward One**

Director Vujnich provided an overview of the petitioner's request to make modifications to this historic building, specifically adding two (2) overhead doors to the front façade of it. This particular façade abuts Manchester Road (also Historic Route 66). He noted this request was also presented to the City's Historic Preservation Commission, which was supportive of the alterations. Director Vujnich stated the Department is seeking the Board's input and direction regarding this request, given it is a commercial building in the City's Town Center Area, as well as being listed on the City's Historic Register.

Secretary Ritter invited members of the public to address the Board regarding this item.

**Steve Scott, Historic Preservation Commission Member**, provided an overview of the Historic Preservation Commission's discussion regarding this matter and explained his dissenting vote regarding the request, specifically relating to the material chosen for the overhead doors.

A motion by Secretary Ritter, seconded by Board Member Sineni, to approve the request, as submitted. A voice was taken regarding the motion. Hearing no objections, Secretary Ritter declared the motion approved unanimously.
