On December 31, 2021, Governor Mike Parson did not renew the State of Missouri's COVID-19 related State of Emergency, effectively ending all statutory and regulatory waivers authorized under it, including the option for City Council to meet virtually. While boards, committees and commissions are still legally permitted to meet via the Zoom platform, the City Administrator has left that decision up to each individual board, committee, or commission.

The Department respectfully requests the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) consider at tonight's meeting how it would like to meet in 2022. The following options are available to the Commission:

1. **Continue to Meet via the Zoom Platform (No Change)**
2. **Meet In-Person (Hybrid Format)** – Commissioners are invited to resume meetings in-person; however, meetings will be required to take place in City Council Chambers, where technology is available to allow participation through the Zoom platform. The hybrid approach would accommodate those Commissioners and members of the public who wish to use it.

As discussed at the December 2021 meeting of the HPC, City Hall continues to **recommend** masks be worn indoors, and social distancing exercised when possible. At this time, no proof of vaccination is required to enter City Hall or participate in public meetings.
