Attached please find a Liquor License Application ("Application") submitted to the City of Wildwood, on April 8, 2022, by Basil Spice Thai Corp., d/b/a Thai Bistro (the "Applicant"), requesting a Liquor License for Liquor by the Drink, All Kinds and Sunday Sales - Liquor by the Drink, All Kinds, for the premises located at 2436 Taylor Road, Wildwood, Missouri 63040 (the "Proposed Licensed Premises").

Thai Bistro recently had a change of ownership, which necessitates a liquor license being issued to the new owner.

The Department of Planning has verified zoning compliance and approved the Application. The Police Department has also approved the Application and has confirmed that the neither the Applicant nor its managing officer have been convicted of a felony, a violation of the provisions of any law applicable to the manufacture or sale of intoxicating liquor, or of any crime relating to the distribution, sale or possession of any controlled substance or dangerous drugs. Neither the Applicant nor its employees have ever had a liquor license revoked, denied, or suspended.

The Proposed Licensed Premises is within 200 feet of a church. Notice of the public hearing was sent to all property owners of property located within 200 feet of the Proposed Licensed Premises (property lot line).

A hearing before the City Council to consider the Application is scheduled for the April 25, 2022 City Council meeting. If you have any questions relating to the Application, please feel free to contact me prior to the hearing.
