

Old State Road

Summary of City of Wildwood Work

- 2016 Old State Road Conceptual Study
 - City/County and Ellisville hired HR Green to complete a conceptual improvement plan for future improvements to Old State Road from north of Ridge to Old Fairway.
 - The proposed improvements included a 10' shared use path along the west (north) side of Old State Road with a grade separated crossing north of Lakeshore Meadows Drive, and either signals or roundabouts at Old Fairway and Ridge Road.
 - Estimated cost for the improvements was \$10.7M-\$10.9M.
 - Wildwood's cost for the engineering was \$21,000.
- 2017 Sidewalk/Crosswalk Project
 - Wildwood constructed about 1,300' of new sidewalk along the west side of Old State Road from Harbour Pointe Drive to Ridge Road. This work added a new crosswalk over Old State Road south of Ridge Road.
 - The Project was bid in the fall of 2016, and construction was complete by summer 2017.
 - Crosswalk and sidewalk cost was \$133,726
 - City is responsible for maintaining the sidewalk.
- 2018 STP Federal Funding Application
 - St. Louis County, with Wildwood and Ellisville, jointly applied for STP funding for the roundabout at Ridge Road, with an estimated cost of \$1.7M, but was not successful. Wildwood's share was 1/3 of the 50% local match.
- 2021 STP Federal Funding Application
 - Wildwood and Ellisville, jointly applied for STP funds for the project, but was unsuccessful.
- 2022 Crosswalk/Flashing Beacon Project
 - Wildwood worked with St. Louis County to install flashing beacons at the existing crosswalk south of Ridge Road. County provided the materials, and our contractor made the installation at City cost of \$9,740
 - St. Louis County also restriped and re-aligned the Ridge Road approach to Old State Road for motorist safety.
