

RESOLUTION #2023-1

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE EAST-WEST GATEWAY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AND THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FEDERAL FUNDING OF A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO REPLACE BRIDGE #387 LOCATED ON WILD HORSE CREEK ROAD, ABOUT 1,300 FEET NORTH OF OSSENFORT ROAD, UNDER THE SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM - SUBALLOCATED (STP-S) FUNDING PROGRAM FOR THE ST. LOUIS REGION

WHEREAS, the Federal Surface Transportation Program - Suballocated (STP-S) provides federal funding to municipalities through the Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood desires to undertake a capital improvement project to replace the existing Bridge #387 located on Wild Horse Creek Road, about 1,300 feet north of Ossenfort Road; and

WHEREAS, the proposed capital improvement project will benefit the residents of the City by providing a safer crossing over Wild Horse Creek; and

WHEREAS, by obtaining federal funds, the City can leverage its existing capital improvement funds as the local match, which would be 20% of the project's estimated construction cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Council of the City of Wildwood hereby authorizes and approves submission of the Application for 80% federal funding for improvements to construct a new bridge to replace existing Bridge #387 on Wild Horse Creek Road about 1,300 feet north of Ossenfort Road. The total estimated construction costs are \$2,645,000. If funding is approved, the City will provide a local match of 20% of the construction costs in the appropriate fiscal years.

Section Two. The Council of the City of Wildwood hereby authorizes, empowers and directs the Mayor to execute, acknowledge, deliver and administer on behalf of the City such Application to the East-West Gateway Council of Governments and the Missouri Department of Transportation, including submitting an Application Fee totaling \$10,580, which shall be refunded if federal funding is not approved.

Section Three. The Director of Public Works is authorized to notify the East-West Gateway Council of Governments and the Missouri Department of Transportation of the application for funding through the Transportation Improvement Program.

Section Four. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to, on behalf of the City, execute any subsequent amendments or other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.

Section Five. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
