Under the direction of the task force members, the two (2) consultants have been investigating the five (5) basins that had been identified a number of months ago for potential retrofits. These basins are located in the following subdivisions:

1. B&B Theatre.
2. Copper Lakes.
3. Harbors at Lake Chesterfield.
4. Westglen Farms.
5. Wynncrest.

The Homeowners Associations have authorized access to these basins for the purposes of this study and the consideration of these facilities for their potential retrofits as well.

The investigations are nearing their conclusions and the preliminary report is anticipated in February. At tonight's meeting, the consultants will be in attendance via Zoom and provide an update on the report and offer some insights in this regard.
