I, therefore, waive and release, and agree to hold harmless, the City of Wildwood, Missouri, the Garden Manager(s), and any garden member from and for any liability, damage, loss, or claim that arises out of or in connection with my participation in the community garden.

Additionally, as a gardener at the community garden, I agree to participate in a minimum of **two (2) Member Work Events** during the 2019 Season, which were selected as part of this on-line registration process. Due to unanticipated scheduling conflicts, you may revise these chosen dates by contacting the Garden Manager(s) and/or City Staff, in advance of your scheduled times.
