# Wildwood 2020 Vision Plan

## *Friends and neighbors:*

I spent my first year as Mayor listening – listening to you and other residents that attended our Council meetings, my monthly Coffees with the Mayor, and other events. I also gathered input from our residents in numerous one-on-one conversations.

That input led me to develop my Wildwood 2020 Vision Plan for our City, which I unveiled in October of last year.

The Vision Plan has five components designed to improve your resident experience. The Plan is also intended to renew our focus on our City's original plan – larger residential lots in town center, protecting our trees and green space.

### **THE FIVE PARTS OF THE PLAN INCLUDE:**

- Cleaning debris and beautifying all of our primary roadways

- Maximizing utilization of green space in areas owned by our City, and in private developments
- Determining whether you and our other residents want a public activity venue (with associated costs), and if so, the type of venue
- Reaffirming our commitment to the original Town Center Plan by requiring more green space, and larger and varying residential lots
- Enhancing Manchester Road from the Wildwood Middle School to Taylor Road
