

CITY OF WILDWOOD DRIVE APPROACH STANDARDS

Streets designed for residential and non-residential developments within the City of Wildwood shall comply with “Design Criteria for the Preparation of Improvement plans” compiled by St. Louis County Department of Highways and Traffic and subsequent amendments with the following exceptions:

1. **Subgrade Preparation:** The upper twelve (12) inches of the subgrade soil shall be compacted at least 95 percent of the standard Proctor (AASHTO T-99) maximum dry density at a moisture content of no more than 110 percent of optimum moisture (AASHTO T-99).
2. **Granular Base and Sub-base Layers:** Provide a four (4) inch thick granular base layer on all PCC and asphalt concrete streets.
3. **Pavement Thickness:** To be six (6) inches of concrete or eight (8) inches of asphalt.
4. **Drive Approach Maintenance:** Shall be the responsibility of the adjacent homeowner.

SIDEWALK DESIGN STANDARDS

All sidewalks shall consist of the following:

1. Placed on two (2) inches of compacted sub-base to 95 percent compaction on Type 2 aggregate.
2. Four (4) feet in width with a joint spacing of five (5) feet (maximum).
3. Installation of expansion required every twenty (20) feet.
