A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, FOR FORMATION OF A TASK FORCE TO ADDRESS CITY OF WILDWOOD COMMUNITY OUTREACH

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood offers a number of different city-sponsored community outreach opportunities for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood has a diverse community of citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood's residents are also served by a number of civic and non-profit entities that offer varying community outreach programs; and


WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has greatly affected community resource and outreach utilization directly impacting the City of Wildwood community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The City Council of the City of Wildwood hereby creates a Community Outreach Task Force to evaluate community outreach programs provided by the City and local nonprofit/civic groups in relation to the current needs of Wildwood residents, especially in the COVID-19 pandemic, and specifically, to identify areas that may improve community outreach for Wildwood residents in conjunction with such local nonprofit/civic entities.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Wildwood Community Outreach Task Force will be comprised of three City of Wildwood Council Members and eight additional members who shall be Wildwood residents and/or leaders of local nonprofit/civic groups.
